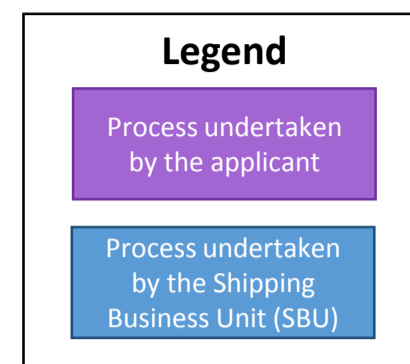


New Temporary Licence

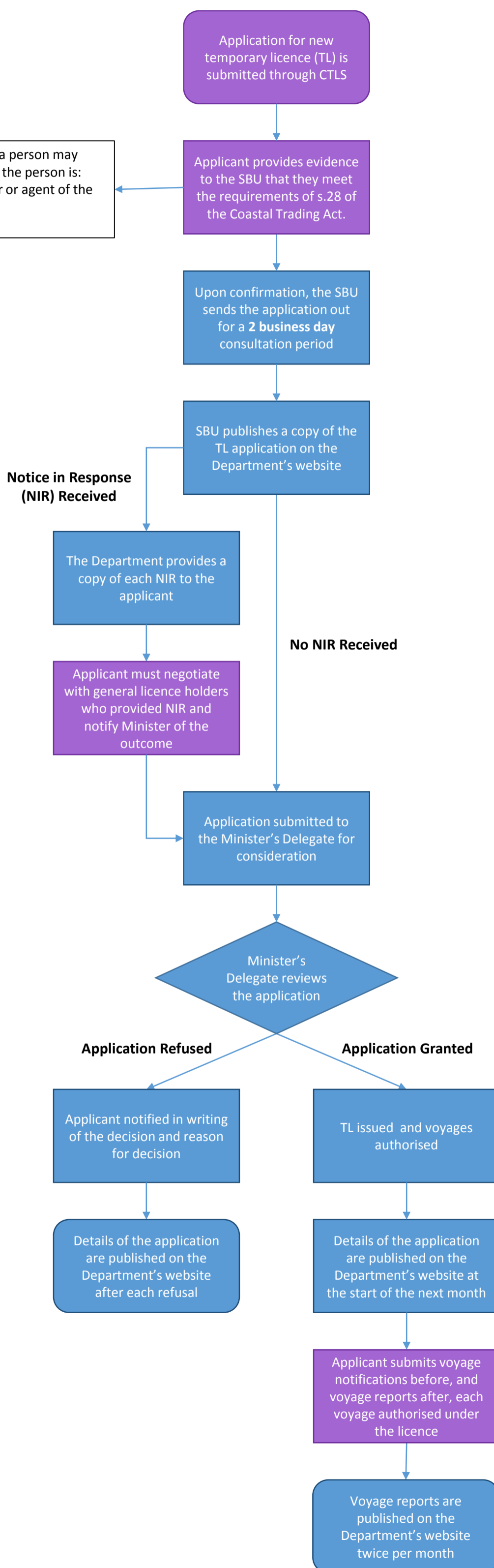
A temporary licence provides access to engage in coastal trading in Australian for a 12-month period, limited to the voyages authorised under the licence. For more information relating to temporary licences, please visit the [Frequently Asked Questions](#) page.

Please note: This flowchart is representative only and does not replace the legislation. Please refer to the *Coastal Trading (Revitalising Australian Shipping) Act 2012* (Coastal Trading Act) to confirm legislative requirements.

Section 28 of the Act states that “a person may apply...for a temporary licence...if the person is:
a) the owner, charterer, master or agent of the vessel; or
b) a shipper.”



Temporary Licence Summary	
Cost	\$400
Consultation period	2 business days
Processing timeframe	15 business days
Validity	1 year



An NIR stops the clock for considering applications

The Minister's Delegate must consider new TL applications **within 15 days** of the date received

Voyage notifications must be submitted at least 2 business days before the actual loading date of the voyage.
Voyage reports must be submitted no later than 10 days after the completion of the voyage.
